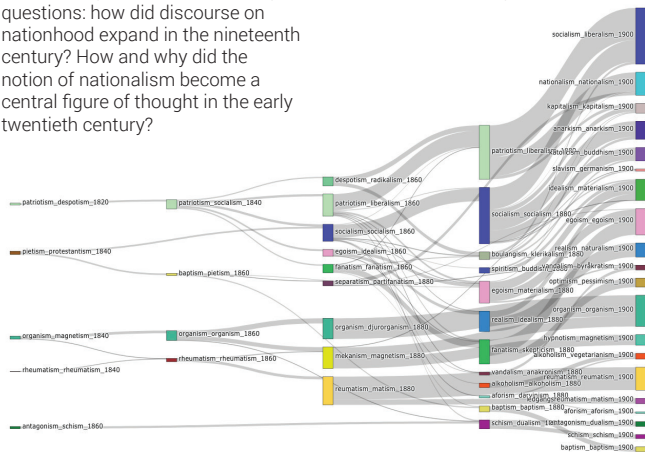

The case study on nationalism focuses on the changing language of nationhood in the late 19th and early 20th century. It asks the following questions: how did discourse on nationhood expand in the nineteenth century? How and why did the notion of nationalism become a central figure of thought in the early twentieth century?

The case combines qualitative reading of sources with frequency analysis and word embedding models to cluster key terms.
